# Welcome to 4-H Teen Works!

The Washington State University Thurston County Extension 4-H Teen Works program offers training, resources, and other fun experiences to help teens prepare for life after high school. Teens 13 - 18 who live in Thurston County are eligible to join. The spring session runs from March through June. Most tracks meet every other week, but some schedules are different.

## **Expectations**

- Full participation in one or more career exploration tracks. Choose one or two from the offerings listed in this schedule.
- Attend monthly Company Meetings.
- Participate in a minimum of one educational field trip.
- Complete a minimum of one service project.
- Maintain records as needed.

*Company Meetings:* All members are expected to attend Company Meetings. They are scheduled the first Monday of every month from 5:30 – 7:00 pm, and will be located at the WSU Extension Offices unless otherwise noted.

*Educational Field Trips:* These trips will be scheduled throughout the year. Teen Works members are expected to attend a minimum of one per year. These trips may range from visiting WSU Vancouver, to the Quinault National Forest, or to the Experience Music Project.

*Service Projects:* Each Teen Works member is also required to participate in a minimum of one Service Project per year. Possible projects include: volunteering for the annual Olympia Ethnic Celebration, participating in recruitment/promotional events, or environmental activities.
